Administrative Matters

Stormwater Program Update

Staff provided an update on recent activities as follows:

Outreach and Education

Staff participated in the state Envirothon, Earth Day, and Carrboro Streets. Upcoming events include Carrboro Day, and summer events are being scheduled.

Other

Carrboro is partnering with Haw River Assembly to install a trash trout on Morgan Creek.

Residential Assessment Pilot Project

Staff gave the background that led up to the Residential Assessment Pilot Project. The pilot project has ended, and staff discussed the Stormwater Division’s report and survey results. Mike Dupree, the contractor for the pilot project, gave a presentation on his assessments, the accompanying report, and future recommendations. SWAC members, staff, and Mr. Dupree discussed the project and reports; there appeared to be interest in further deliberation at future meetings.

Recommendations for Jade Creek SUP

Mike served as scribe for capturing the SWAC Jade Creek recommendations to Town Council. Past comments were discussed, and recommendations/comments were officially documented. Document will be signed and submitted to the Planning Department.
