Welcome to Carrboro! We hope you review this brochure and visit our facilities soon! The facilities are conveniently located throughout the community. From the 55 acre Anderson Community Park to the smaller neighborhood parks, to the Century Center,



Carrboro provides outdoor facilities and one indoor facility for a variety of leisure experiences. You can play horseshoes, tennis

or softball. You could also go fishing, take a walk or have a picnic. You could even host a wedding reception or birthday party.

Most park facilities are open from 7 am until dark (unless noted), except for lighted facilities, which close at 11 pm. The Century Center hours are 9:00am to 5:00pm. Monday through Friday. Any requested hours beyond normal operational hours are pending the availability of staff and rental reservations.
