Calls for Service

Calls for service are generated either by citizen complaints or by officers self-initiating. These calls range from a request for a vehicle unlock, to a suspicious person, to a traffic stop, to more serious criminal matters with all requiring the presence or response of an officer to resolve, correct or assist in that situation.

In June 2022, The Carrboro Police Department recorded 1,559 calls for service as compared to 1,345 in the same month the previous year (2021).

Traffic Stops: In June 2022, Carrboro Police performed 157 traffic stops. As a result of those stops, 75 citations were issued, 38 verbal warnings given, 31 written warnings issued, 8 on-view arrests were made and 5 where no action was taken.

Citations: In June 2022, Carrboro Police issued 92 citations. 31 were regulatory traffic citations, 10 were safety/moving violations, 37 were for speeding, 4 for trespassing, 2 for simple affray, 1 each for drunk in public, public urination, pedestrian crossing violation, reckless driving/wanton disregard, hit and run with property damage, sell/give malt beverage to minor, shoplifting, and child restraint violation.

Arrests: In June 2022, the Carrboro Police Department made 36 on-view/custodial arrests. 35 charges were misdemeanor arrests: ranging from assault, breaking and entering, drug possession, failure to appear in court, DWI, DWLR impaired rev, communicating threats, injury to real/personal property, larceny, repeat stalking, sale of alcohol to a minor, simple affray and 1 for Felony elude arrest mv with 2 aggravating factors.

Incident Reports: There were 283 Incidents reported to the Carrboro Police Department for the month of June 2022, as compared to 276 in the same month from last year (2021).

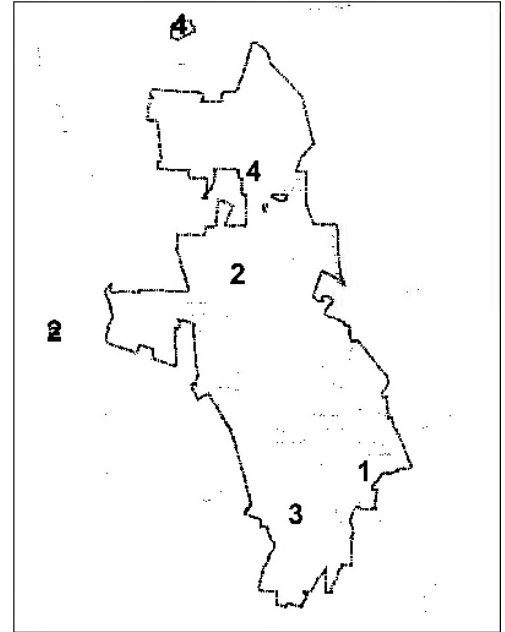
Crashes: There were 27 traffic crashes in the month June, which included no fatalities.
